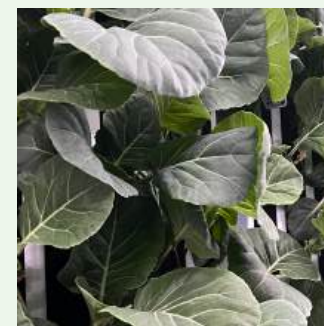

Earthy and sultry sweet, beets add color and depth to any dish.



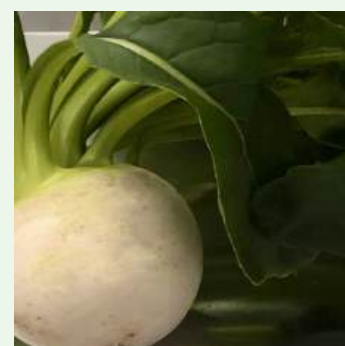
Parisian Carrots

Earthy with a lightly bitter and peppery flavor. Great for teas and medicinal products.



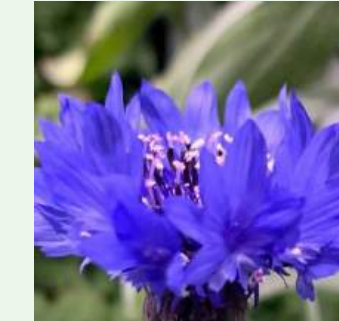
Borage
